Procurement Strategy Summary Note

1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 The Procurement Strategy paper will set out the options, issues and proposals relating to high level procurement of all aspects of the Croxley Rail Link project. It will examine optional strategies for the Central Section (Metropolitan Link to Network Rail Link), the Metropolitan Link Section, and the Network Rail Section (Network Rail Link to Watford Junction). Recommendations are currently being sought regarding the details of the Contract Strategy to enable the contract to be let by Hertfordshire County Council.
- 1.2 In order to reach agreement between Hertfordshire County Council (HCC), London Underground (LU) and Network Rail (NR) on relevant procurement strategies for the various sections, a procurement strategy meeting was held on 18th May 2011 attended by the following:

The structure of the meeting was to consider the various options available for each section, and to reach agreement on the options acceptable to all parties and best for the project. In reaching a decision about which elements fall under which type of contract, the discussion considered cost certainty, risk transfer and value for money. It was also recognised that some enabling works will be carried out in advance of letting the main contract, such as environmental works and confirmation of stats locations.

- 1.4 The nature of the scheme is such that there are a number of rail industry interfaces, and in order to manage cost and to provide clarity, a body will be established to address these issues.
- 1.5 The Procurement Strategy report will detail the proposed strategy for each work element, based on the workshop above. The Procurement Strategy will be

submitted as part of the Best and Final Bid application for Croxley Rail Link in early September. A summary of the proposed strategy for each work element is shown in the table below.
